

Pathways for child safety and wellbeing

It is your responsibility to know your responsibilities

Protecting children is everyone's responsibility and while some professionals hold mandatory reporting obligations, we all have a role and responsibility in ensuring children and young people are safe from harm, abuse and their wellbeing is supported.



If a child is immediately at risk call Emergency Services

At all times throughout – you must:

- respond to an emergency
- adapt to changing circumstances
- document your actions

If **not** immediately at risk support child and monitor risk throughout

Identify pre-existing support service

Follow information sharing process

Identify physical or sexual abuse
(mandatory reporting)

Contact existing agency

Request The Orange Door secondary consultation / referral

Report to Child Protection

Advice / referral to other service provided
no further action

Referral received and actioned by The Orange Door
(risk-based consultation may occur with Child Protection as required)
